

Remedial Math and English Composition Courses

Students who test or place into MATH 0029, MATH 0030, and/or ENGCOMP 0150:

- Are automatically placed on academic probation if they place in both lower-level (remedial) math and composition courses and may not take more than 13 credit hours (14 credit hours, if one of the courses taken is a foreign language or physical education course) during their first term.
- Are strongly advised to take IL 0210 as one of their courses.
- Must take these math and/or composition courses during their first term at UPT and every subsequent term until all are passed.
- Will not be permitted to withdraw from these courses.
- Must pass all remedial courses with at least a C- on the first attempt and may not repeat these courses *with the following two exceptions*:
 1. Students who are taking two remedial courses during their first term and who fail to earn at least C- in one of the remedial courses but earn a C- or higher grade in each of their other courses will be allowed one more chance to pass the failed (less than C-) remedial course.
 2. Students who earn D, D-, or D+ grades in both remedial courses but earn C or higher grades in each of their other courses will be permitted to attempt the remedial courses for a second time.

[Note: These exceptions apply only to the first attempt. No one will be allowed to take a remedial course for a third time.]

Students who fail to pass the remedial courses with at least a C- on the first attempt (unless one of the two exceptions applies) will be immediately dismissed from the university.
