(2) General Education Requirements and declaration of a major. (3) Completion of pre-requisites for the chosen major.

<b><u>SCHOOL OF NURSING IN PITTSBURGH</u></b>		
24	Minimum GPA of 3.30 required to apply	BIOSC 0212, 0213, 0214, and 0215; CHEM 0910; BIOSC 0031 and 0032; ENGCMP 0200; FS 0004; MATH 0031; PSY 0010; PSYED 0005; plus approved elective(s).
<b><u>SCHOOL OF HEALTH AND REHABILITATION SCIENCES</u></b>		
60 (Including prerequisites for specific program)	Minimum GPA of 2.5 required to apply	Applicants must have completed a minimum of 60 college credits, including specific prerequisite courses which vary from program to program.

\*Students enrolled at the regional campuses can be admitted to Arts and Sciences or General Studies (traditional students only) after the completion of 30 credits with a 3.0 GPA if their high school credentials and test results would have enabled them to be admitted to Arts and Sciences directly from high school.
