

University of Pittsburgh at Titusville Residence Facilities Information Sheet

Room and Board rates can be found on the University of Pittsburgh at Titusville website at <http://upt.pitt.edu/admissions/tuition-and-fees> and they are always subject to change. Single room options may be available at an additional cost, space permitting.

Room Reservation Fee

A \$200 deposit for all new freshmen and transfer students or a \$100 Room Reservation Fee for all returning students is required to reserve your room and is refundable if you notify the Office of Student Life in writing or email by June 30. We will also return this fee for the following reasons:

1. Relocation of the student to any other University of Pittsburgh campus prior to the termination of the housing contract.
2. Involuntary military service.
3. Verified medical resignation.
4. Death of the student.

Types of Residence Facilities

The University of Pittsburgh at Titusville offers two residence areas, which are described below.

Spruce Residence Hall

Coed by floor

A traditional residence hall accommodating 158 students in 82 mostly double rooms on three floors. Each floor includes a common student area and common bathroom facilities. The first floor also has a large lounge, vending area, and laundry facilities.

Townhouses

Coed by unit

The Townhouses are a unique form of on campus living usually reserved for students with 3.0 GPA or higher in addition to one of our Freshman Year Experience facilities. Each house is made up of four double occupancy rooms with two common upstairs bathroom facilities. The main floor includes a large common area for watching television or studying. A washroom, laundry facility, and kitchenette complete this residence.

Notes:

The Townhouses are a waitlist option this year. If you would like to be considered for a Townhouse room, should a room be available, please select the Townhouse option as your first choice online and follow up with an email to Stephanie Fiely, Director of Student Life, at stthomas@pitt.edu and request to be placed on the Townhouse housing waitlist.

Like all University of Pittsburgh buildings, the residence halls are smoke and alcohol free. Any student who wishes to smoke may do so in designated areas outside the buildings.

Dining Facilities

All meals for the meal plan will be available in McKinney Commons Dining Hall. Dining hall hours will be Monday – Friday from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays hours will be 11:30 A.M. until 6:30 P.M. All students are encouraged to purchase Flex Dollars which are used just like cash in all campus dining operations. Flex Dollars can be used in the dining hall for paying for a friend's meal, at Boomer's for individual purchases or special meals offered during the school year, and at the Book Center for food and beverage purchases. Please note, however, any unused Flex Dollars at the end of the term are forfeited.
